

Liver Disease: Could You Have It?



Easy and non-invasive testing to find out



Did you know that **1 in 4** Canadians may be affected by liver disease in their lifetime?

This spring, Liver Canada's Liver Beware Project is back, offering free testing to identify liver stiffness and scarring. The Fibroscan is easy and non-invasive, using ultrasound technology to measure liver stiffness, and can also determine the approximate amount of fat in the liver. This testing is open to Canadians who reside in Greater Vancouver.

Our goal is to understand the prevalence of metabolic dysfunction-associated steatotic liver disease (MASLD, commonly referred to as fatty liver disease) in the general population, to better direct liver disease education and treatment. MASLD is on the rise in Canada and is estimated to be the primary indication for liver transplants in the near future.

DON'T WAIT! Liver disease is often silent. When symptoms arise, it is often too late.
