Liver Disease

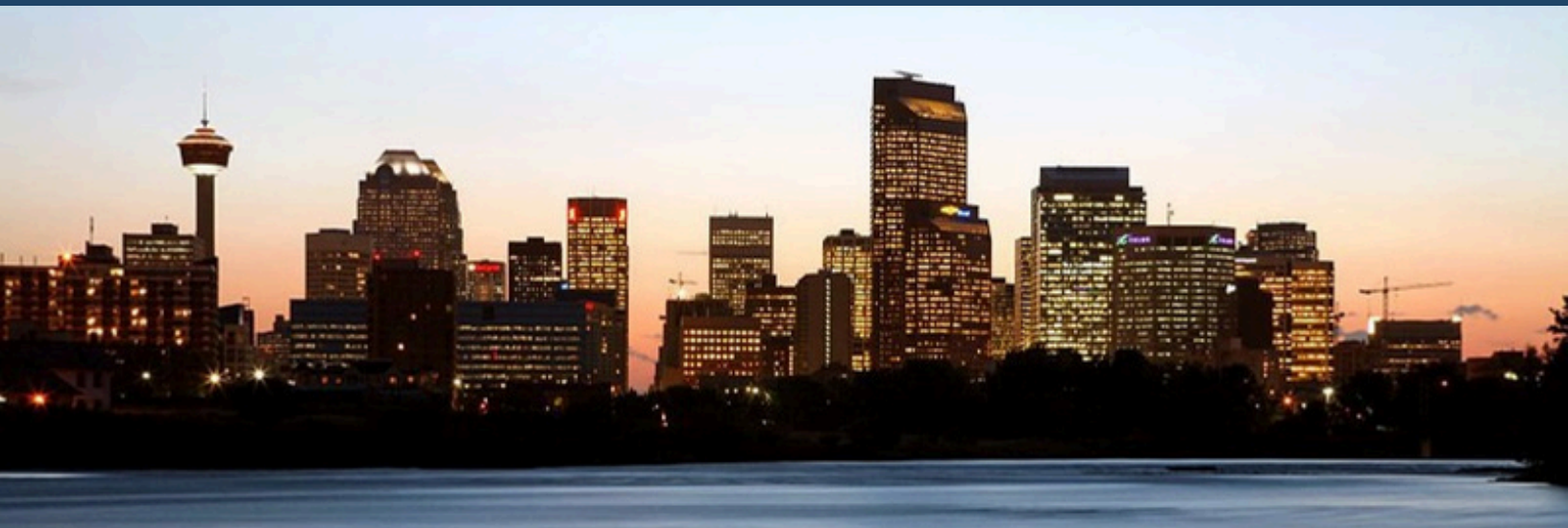
The liver is a vital organ responsible for over 500 functions essential for life, including energy provision, blood cleansing, and hormone regulation. However, it is susceptible to damage from viruses, toxins and diseases, with over 100 liver diseases identified.

Liver disease is on the rise in Canada, now affecting 1 in 4 Canadians. However, many liver diseases progress slowly and may not be discovered until they reach an advanced stage. For these reasons, investment in liver research, public education, and support are critical to prevent liver disease from taking hold and to improve liver health for all Canadians.

Liver Canada

Liver Canada, formally called the Canadian Liver Foundation, was first established in 1969 out of the passion and concern of a committed group of business leaders and doctors who believed that liver disease needed a champion. Today, Liver Canada is a leading organization dedicated to promoting liver health, increasing public awareness and understanding of liver disease, and providing support to individuals affected by liver disease.

We remain the only non-governmental organization in Canada focused on liver health and the main source of non-profit funding for all forms of liver disease. With the help of volunteers, those with lived experiences, researchers, doctors, donors, and corporate sponsors, we are changing the future of liver health for all Canadians.

After his diagnosis with a rare autoimmune condition that led to liver cirrhosis, he faced his illness with remarkable resilience and inspired his family, friends, and others living with similar challenges.
